**AN ORDINANCE ORDERING THE RAZING AND REMOVAL OF A CERTAIN STRUCTURE WITHIN THE CITY OF ROGERS, ARKANSAS, LOCATED AT 512 SOUTH 2<sup>ND</sup> STREET; TO DECLARE AN EMERGENCY; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.**

**WHEREAS**, Vint B. Eubanks, is the owner of certain real property situated in Rogers, Benton County, Arkansas, more particularly described as follows:

The North 50 Feet of Lot 4, Block 2, J. Wade Sikes Addition, Rogers, Benton County, Arkansas.

**WHEREAS**, the structure on the property is unfit for human habitation, constitutes a fire hazard, and is otherwise a dangerous to human life, or constitutes a hazard to safety or health by reason of inadequate maintenance, dilapidation, obsolescence, or abandonment, and further is unsightly, and is considered an unsafe and unsightly structure in violation of City of Rogers Code of Ordinance, Sections 18-55 through 18-68; more specifically, the following violations have been found to exist:

1. This building has been deemed an unsafe and dangerous structure. The building or structure is neglected, damaged, dilapidated, unsecured or abandoned so as to become an attractive nuisance to children who might play in the building or structure to their danger, becomes a harbor for vagrants, criminals or immoral persons, or enables persons to resort to the building or structure for committing a nuisance or an unlawful act. (IPMC § 108.1.5 (7)).

**WHEREAS**, the owner has been notified by the City of Rogers prior to the consideration of this ordinance, that the structure on the property is in violation of variance ordinances of the City of Rogers;

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to City of Rogers Code of Ordinances Section 18-57, the owner was given fourteen (14) calendar days from March 20, 2020 to abate or correct documented violations;

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to City of Rogers Code of Ordinances Section 18-57, a follow up inspection was conducted on April 13, 2020;

**WHEREAS**, the owner has failed, neglected, or refused to comply with the Notice to correct the documented violations, and as such, the matter of condemning, razing and removing the building may be referred to the City Council pursuant to City of Rogers Code of Ordinances Section 18-58;

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to City of Rogers Code of Ordinances Section 18-59(d); a Compliance Inspection was conducted by the Office of Building Inspections on May 12, 2020, which concluded that violations do currently exist; and

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to Arkansas Code Annotated §14-56-203 and City of Rogers Code of Ordinances Chapter 18, Article III, if repair or removal is not done within the required time frame, the City shall have the power to order the removal or razing of, or to remove or raze any buildings that in the opinion of the council have become dilapidated, unsightly, unsafe, unsanitary, obnoxious, or detrimental to the public welfare.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ROGERS, ARKANSAS:**

Section 1: That the structure located at 512 South 2<sup>nd</sup> Street, Rogers, Arkansas, is dilapidated, unsightly, and unsafe; and is in the best interests of the City of Rogers to proceed with the removal of this dilapidated, unsightly, and unsafe structure;

Section 2: That the owner is hereby ordered to raze (demolish) and remove the dilapidated, unsightly, and unsafe structure located on the aforesaid property; and, is further ordered to abate the unsightly conditions on the property. Said work shall be completed within thirty (30) days from the passage of this ordinance. The manner of razing (demolishing) and removing said structure shall be to dismantle by hand or bulldoze and then dispose of all debris, completely cleaning up the property to alleviate any unsightly conditions, in a manner consistent with City of Rogers Code of Ordinances Chapters 10, 18, and 20, and all other state laws and regulations pertaining to the demolition or removal of residential structures;

Section 3: If the aforesaid work is not completed within thirty (30) days, the Mayor, or the Mayor's authorized representative, is hereby directed to cause the aforesaid structure to be razed (demolished) and removed; and the unsafe, unsanitary and unsightly conditions abated; and the City of Rogers shall have a lien upon the aforesaid described real property for the cost of razing (demolishing) and removing said structure and abating said aforementioned conditions, said costs to be determined at a hearing before the City Council;

Section 4: Emergency Clause: The need to raze and remove a certain structure is immediate and in order to protect the public peace, health, safety and welfare an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval;

Section 5: Severability Provision: If any part of this Ordinance is held invalid, the remainder of this Ordinance shall continue in effect as if such invalid portion never existed; and

Section 6: Repeal of Conflicting Ordinances and Resolutions: All ordinances, resolutions or orders of the City Council, or parts of the same, in conflict with this Ordinance are repealed to the extent of such conflict.

ORDINANCE NO. 20-\_\_\_\_\_

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ROGERS CODE SECTION 14-675 BY RE-ZONING CERTAIN LANDS FROM C-2 TO R-O, PROVIDING FOR THE EMERGENCY CLAUSE AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES**

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to the provisions of Rogers Code Section Rogers Code Section 14-725, et seq, and upon the consideration of the report and recommendations of the Planning Commission of the City of Rogers, Benton County, Arkansas, on May 5, 2020, the City Council has found that certain lands hereinafter described are better suited for R-O zoning.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ROGERS, ARKANSAS:**

SECTION 1: That Section 14-675 of the Code of Ordinances, City of Rogers, should be and the same hereby is amended as hereinafter provided.

SECTION 2: That the land hereinafter described should be and the same is hereby zoned as R-O and that said lands being in Benton County, Arkansas, are described as:

**PROPERTY DESCRIPTION:**

Part of the SE ¼ of the NW ¼ of Section 12, Township 19 North, Range 30 West, Benton County, Arkansas described as follows: Beginning at a Point 90 feet east of the SW corner of said SE ¼ of the NW 1/4 run thence north 168 feet, thence East 86.5 feet, thence South 168 feet, Thence West 89.5 feet to the place of beginning, subject to street on the South side thereof. Surveys: 1/21/2014 2014-27

**LAYMAN'S DESCRIPTION:** 1029 West Walnut Street

SECTION 3: **Zoning.** That the above described lands are better suited for R-O than C-2 zoning and same should be and are hereby zoned R-O.

SECTION 4: **Emergency Clause.** That it is necessary to bring proposed uses of the property into conformance with the Rogers City Zoning Ordinances and because of such an emergency is declared to exist and in order to protect the public peace, health, safety and welfare, this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from the date of its passage and approval.

SECTION 5: **Severability Provision.** In the event that any section, paragraph, subdivision, clause, phrase, or other provision or portion of this Ordinance shall be adjudged invalid or unconstitutional, the same shall not affect the validity of this Ordinance as a whole, or any part or provision, other than the part so decided to be invalid or unconstitutional, and the remaining provisions of this Ordinance shall be construed as if such invalid, unenforceable or unconstitutional provision or provisions had never been contained herein.

SECTION 6: **Repeal of Conflicting Ordinances and Resolutions.** All ordinances, resolutions or orders of the City Council, or parts of ordinances, resolutions or orders of the City Council in conflict herewith are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.

**ORDINANCE NO. 20-\_\_\_\_\_**

**AN ORDINANCE ACCEPTING THE ANNEXATION OF CERTAIN  
TERRITORY TO THE CITY OF ROGERS; APPROVING THE SCHEDULE OF  
SERVICES TO BE EXTENDED TO SAID AREA; ASSIGNING SUCH TO  
WARDS; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.**

**WHEREAS**, a petition was filed, pursuant to Ark. Code Ann. § 14-40-609, for the annexation of certain territory into the City of Rogers, Arkansas;

**WHEREAS**, the Benton County Assessor and the Benton County Clerk have completed the following:

- a. Verified the identity of the petitioner(s);
- b. Verified that there are no property owners included in the petition that do not wish to have their property annexed;
- c. Verified that the property or properties are contiguous with the City of Rogers;
- d. Verified that no enclaves will be created if the petition is accepted by the City of Rogers; and
- e. Presented the petition and their respective verifications to the Benton County Judge; and

**WHEREAS**, the County Judge has completed the following:

- a. Reviewed the petition and verifications for completeness and accuracy;
- b. Determined that no enclaves will be created by the annexation;
- c. Confirmed that the petition contains a schedule of services;
- d. Found that the land to be annexed shall include certain dedicated public roads and rights of way abutting or traversing said property; and
- e. Issued an order articulating these findings and forwarded the petition and order to the contiguous City of Rogers for consideration; and

**WHEREAS**, it is the desire of the Rogers City Council that said territory, more fully described below, be annexed.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ROGERS, ARKANSAS THAT:**

Section 1: That the following described territory, contiguous to the City of Rogers, be and the same is hereby accepted as part of, and annexed to and made a part of the City of Rogers, Arkansas:

PART OF THE NW 1/4 OF THE SE 1/4 OF SECTION 19, TOWNSHIP 19 NORTH, RANGE 29 WEST, BENTON COUNTY, ARKANSAS MORE PARTICULARLY DESCRIBED AS FOLLOWS: FROM THE NE CORNER OF SAID NW 1/4, SE 1/4, OF SECTION 19 RUN, THENCE WEST 988.80 FEET; THENCE SOUTH 323.80 FEET TO THE POINT OF BEGINNING; THENCE S17°40'17"W 297.00 FEET; THENCE N76°19'20"W 208.00 FEET TO THE CENTERLINE OF OLD WIRE ROAD; THENCE N18°51'13"E 107.94 FEET ALONG SAID CENTERLINE; THENCE N24°19'34"E 192.08 FEET ALONG SAID CENTERLINE; THENCE S76°19'20"E 183.45 FEET TO THE POINT OF BEGINNING, SUBJECT TO THE RIGHT-OF-WAY OF OLD WIRE ROAD.

**LAYMAN'S DESCRIPTION: 2511 S. Old Wire Road, Rogers**

Section 2: That the following schedule of services shall be extended to the area by the City of Rogers within the statutorily required three (3) year period after the date the annexation becomes final, as follows:

- a. Law Enforcement,
- b. Life Safety; and,
- c. Water and Sewer Services

Section 3: That the above described territory shall be annexed to and made a part of Ward 4 of the City of Rogers, and the same shall henceforth be a part of said ward as fully as existing parts of said ward;

Section 4: That the above described lands are suited for R-DP zoning and said lands should be and are hereby zoned R-DP;

Section 5: That the aforesaid real property should be added to the Rogers Comprehensive Growth Map and designated as "Neighborhood".

Section 6: That thirty (30) days after passage and publication or posting of this Ordinance as authorized by law, the annexation shall be final and the property shall be within the corporate limits of the City of Rogers, except as otherwise ordered by the Circuit Court pursuant to a cause of action filed within said thirty (30) day period;

Section 7: Notice - Within forty-five (45) days of the effective date of this ordinance the City Clerk shall provide written notice, along with complete documentation, to the County Clerk of each county in which the territory is affected;

Section 8: Severability Provision - If any part of this Ordinance is held invalid, the remainder of this Ordinance shall continue in effect as if such invalid portion never existed; and

Section 9: Repeal of Conflicting Provisions - All Ordinances, Resolutions, or Orders of the City Council, or parts of the same, in conflict with this Ordinance are repealed to the extent of such conflict.

**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR AND CITY CLERK TO ENTER INTO A GRANT AGREEMENT WITH THE OFFICE OF JUSTICE PROGRAMS AT THE UNITED STATES DEPARTMENT OF JUSTICE TO RECEIVE UP TO SEVENTY-FIVE THOUSAND FIVE HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$75,500.00); AMENDING THE 2020 BUDGET TO RECOGNIZE GRANT FUNDS IN THAT AMOUNT INTO ACCOUNT #100-03-45620 FEDERAL GRANT CESF; APPROPRIATING THE SAME TO EXPENSE ACCOUNT #100-03-70998 CESF GRANT EXPENSES; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.**

**WHEREAS**, the City of Rogers Police Department wishes to enter into a grant agreement with the Office of Justice Programs at the United States Department of Justice to receive up to seventy-five thousand five hundred dollars (\$75,500.00) to be used for the Coronavirus Emergency Supplemental Funding.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ROGERS, ARKANSAS THAT:**

Section 1: The Mayor and City Clerk are hereby authorized to enter into a grant agreement on behalf of the City of Rogers Police Department with the Office of Justice Programs at the United States Department of Justice in which the City shall accept up to seventy-five thousand five hundred dollars (\$75,500.00) in grant funds for the Coronavirus Emergency Supplemental Funding;

Section 2: The 2020 Budget is hereby amended to recognize grant funds in the amount of seventy-five thousand five hundred dollars (\$75,500.00) to Account #100-03-45620 Federal Grant CESF;

Section 3: The 2020 Budget is further amended to appropriate said seventy-five thousand five hundred dollars (\$75,500.00) into Account #100-03-70998 CESF Grant Expenses;

Section 4: Severability Provision: If any part of this Resolution is held invalid, the remainder of this Resolution shall continue in effect as if such invalid portion never existed; and

Section 5: Repeal of Conflicting Resolutions: All Resolutions or orders of the City Council, or parts of Resolutions or orders of the City Council, in conflict with this Resolution are repealed to the extent of such conflict.
