*The following competencies are identified by the Rogers Fire Department as minimum company standards for all personnel. The competencies are identified as either requisite knowledge (RK) or requisite skills (RS). Under the date column, the company officer must date when the skill was completed and initial, along with the candidate, that each skill / competency was demonstrated or observed. The candidate and the company officer must initial under the appropriate column for each competency. By initialing each competency, the company officer is validating all of the requisite knowledge and skills necessary to complete the competency. If the company officer believes that the candidate needs additional training on a given subject, the additional training / knowledge should be indicated to the DFC-TSS. **It is the company officers responsibility to complete the minimum company standards by June 30, 2012.***
