



## Rogers Fire Department Minimum Company Standards Form 90 - SOP 142



*The following standards are identified by the Rogers Fire Department as minimum company standards for all personnel. Under the date column, the company officer must date when the skill was completed. The firefighter and the company officer must initial under the appropriate column for each competency demonstrated. By initialing each competency, the company officer is validating all of the requisite knowledge and skills necessary to complete the competency were demonstrated. If the company officer believes that the firefighter needs additional training on a given subject, the additional training / knowledge should be indicated under the remarks. **It is the company officer's responsibility to complete these minimum company standards by September 30<sup>th</sup> 2017.***
