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PURPOSE

The purpose of this policy is to establish minimum requirements for working out of classification in the ranks of Fire Equipment Operator/Master Paramedic, Captain and Battalion Chief (Citywide Tour Commander).

POLICY

In order to ensure qualified and prepared candidates work out of classification in the following ranks, these minimum requirements are set:

Fire Equipment Operator / Master Paramedic

1. Minimum of one (1) year experience with the Rogers Fire Department
2. Approved by their assigned company officer and Battalion Chief
3. Successful completion of the Rogers Fire Department Relief Driver Training Program
 - a. Must have already completed a Form 50 on the specific apparatus being operated while working out of classification.

Captain – Field Operations

1. Minimum of six (6) months experience as a Fire Equipment Operator or Master Paramedic Firefighter
2. Approved by their assigned company officer, Battalion Chief, Deputy Chief of Field Operations
3. Passing evaluation for the previous two (2) years
4. Completed Future Company Officer Task Book
5. Must have attained the rank of Fire Equipment Operator or Master Paramedic Firefighter

Battalion Chief – Field Operations / Citywide Tour Commander

1. Minimum of two (2) years experience as a Fire Captain
2. Approved by their Battalion Chief, Deputy Chief of Field Operations and Fire Chief
3. Passing evaluation for the previous three (3) years
4. NIMS 300 and 400 Certification (Effective July 2010)
5. Completed Future Chief Officer Task Book
