### PURPOSE

To ensure that vehicles serving the community are reliable and provide for the safety of personnel this policy will outline the RFD's apparatus replacement guidelines as recommended in NFPA 1901, Standard for Automotive Fire Apparatus.

### POLICY

Each year, the Command Staff shall conduct a survey of the department's apparatus and make adjustments to this policy regarding the replacement of vehicles dependent upon frequency of use, maintenance cost, mileage, engine hours and years of service. However, to ensure the safest and most efficient use resources from the City of Rogers, the following apparatus replacement guidelines shall be the standard practice:

Aerial Apparatus	12 Years	6 Years	18 Years
Pumper Apparatus	12 Years	5 Years	17 Years
Rescue Apparatus	12 Years	6 Years	18 Years
Ambulance Units	6 Years	4 Years	10 Years
Brush Pumper Units	10 Years	5 Years	15 Years
Citywide Tour Commander Vehicle	3 Years	7 Years	10 Years
Staff Vehicles	7 Years	3 Years	10 Years
