



Rogers Fire Department Standard Operating Procedures

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PURPOSE

The purpose of the Officer Development Program is to provide regulated, systematic, and uniform training to all field officers. This program is intended to ensure that all field supervisors receive standardized training commensurate with their rank and according to NFPA Standard 1021: Standard for Fire Officer Professional Qualifications, as applicable to the Rogers Fire Department.

POLICY

The Training Division will prepare and deliver courses specific to the roles and responsibilities of field supervisors. These classes will be collectively referred to as the Officer Development Program and may include multiple courses. These courses will be delivered to officers and personnel seeking advancement, when applicable.

Attendance in the Officer Development Program is required of officers who are scheduled to be on-duty during scheduled sessions.
